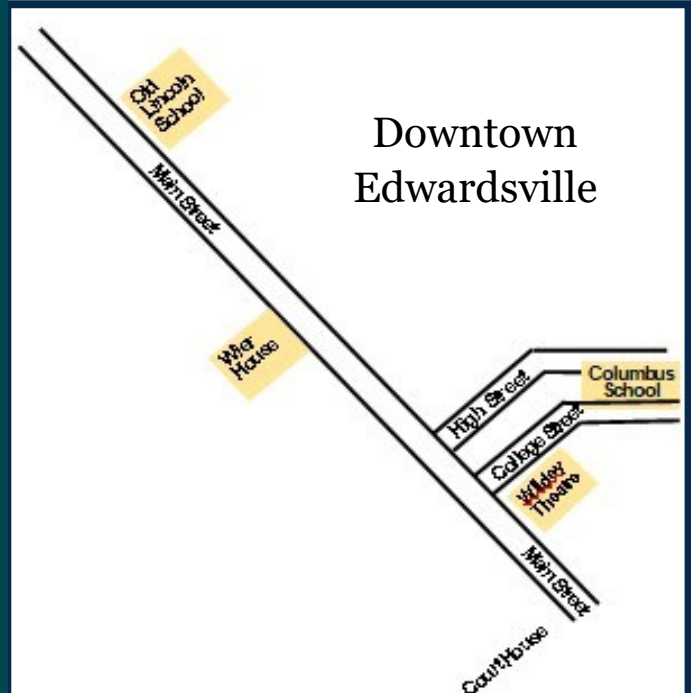

Wildey Theatre Lobby (252 N. Main Street) 10 a.m. and 1 p.m.
